



<b>ROLE</b>	<b>Age Manager</b>
<b>Purpose</b>	Age Managers work with Nippers aged 5-13. The goal is to enrich the lives of junior members through the delivery of surf life saving knowledge and skills in a fun and safe aquatic environment.
<b>Responsible to</b>	Junior Activities Coordinator
<b>Time Commitment</b>	Approx 4 hours per week (in season)
<b>Responsibilities &amp; Duties</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Set up and pack up the beach</li> <li>● Facilitate fun learning programs</li> <li>● Deliver surf lifesaving knowledge and skills</li> <li>● Encourage and develop young surf lifesavers</li> <li>● Create a fun and safe aquatic environment</li> <li>● Closely supervise activities</li> <li>● Ensure records are accurate and to hand</li> <li>● Evaluate Nippers for injury and incapacity</li> <li>● Liaise with parents and RPSLSC members as required</li> <li>● Attend Age Managers Meetings on a Sunday</li> <li>● Encourage nippers to achieve their Surf Education certificates</li> </ul>
<b>Prerequisites</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Be 18 years of age if you are working with under-6 or under-7 groups</li> <li>● Be 15 years of age (minimum) – if managing children in the age groups under 8 upwards</li> <li>● Hold a valid Blue Card</li> <li>● Hold an Age Managers Accreditation or complete course during season</li> <li>● Hold an Observer's Award, Surf Rescue Certificate or SLSA Bronze Medallion.</li> </ul>
<b>Knowledge &amp; Skills Required</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Excellent communication skills with both children and adults</li> <li>● Leadership skills</li> <li>● Patient, kind and encouraging</li> <li>● Creative, proactive, enthusiastic, well-organised</li> <li>● Must be a financial member of the Club</li> <li>● Candidates must also be the holder of a current Blue Card</li> </ul>
